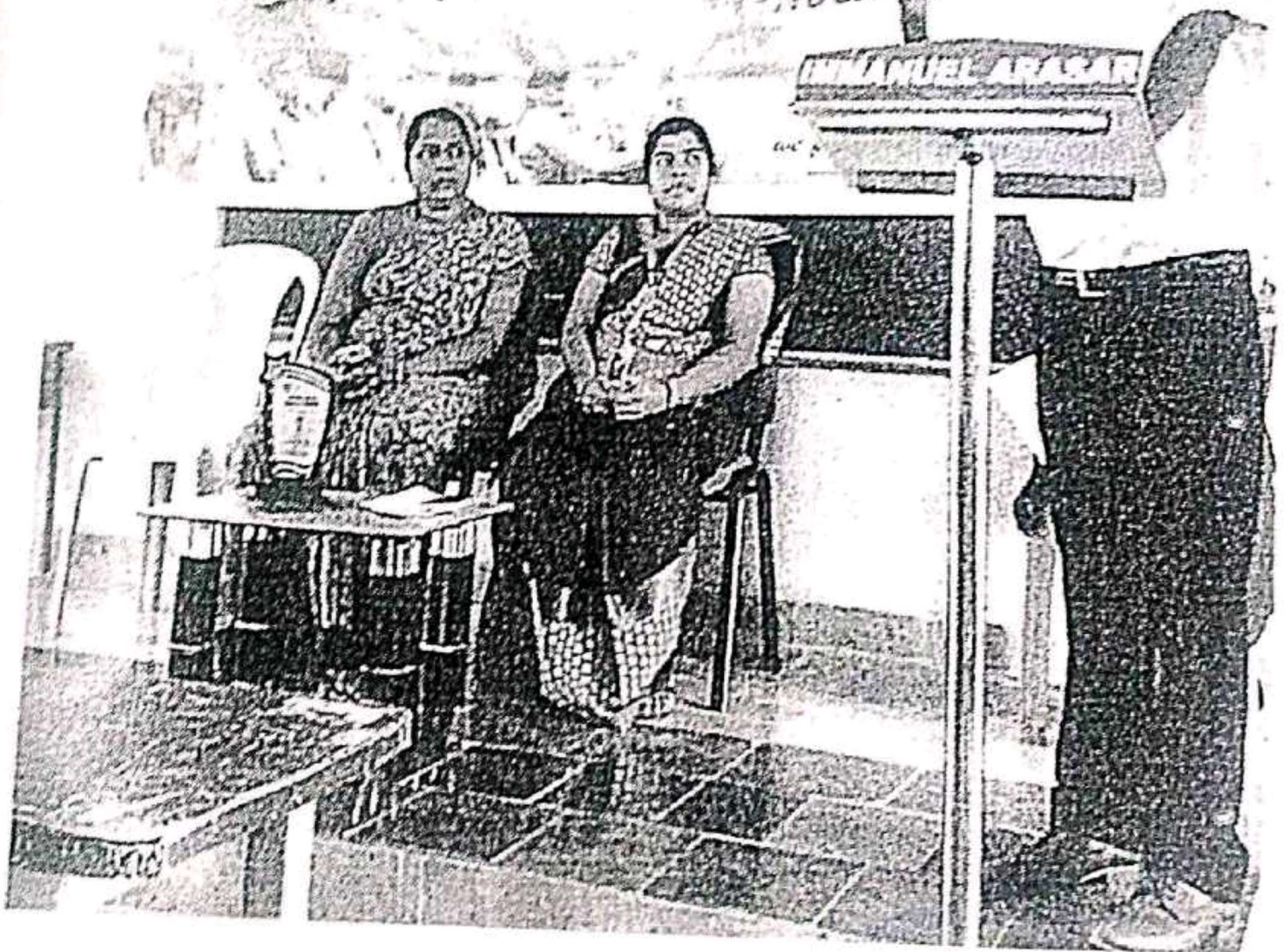
English Workshop [2018-2019]

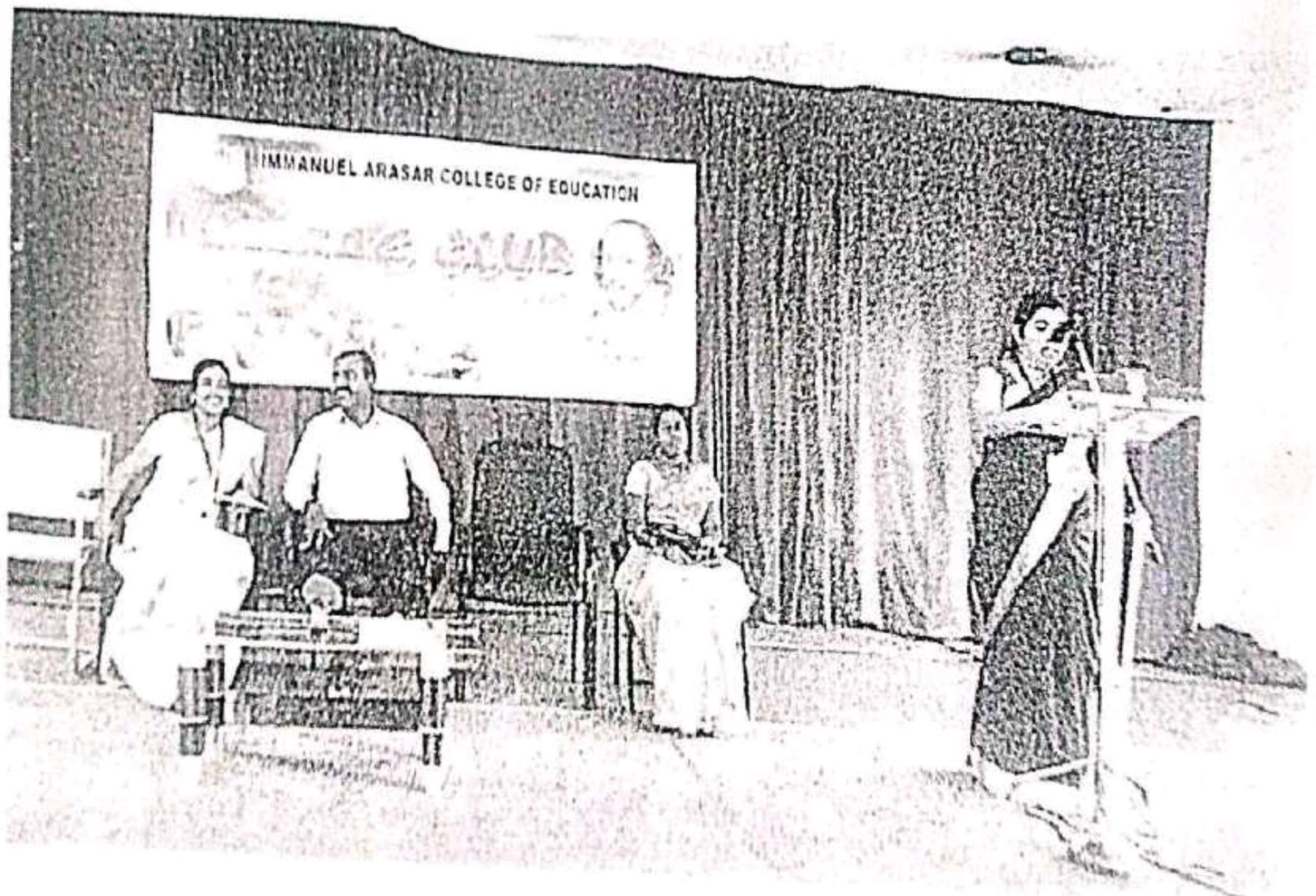
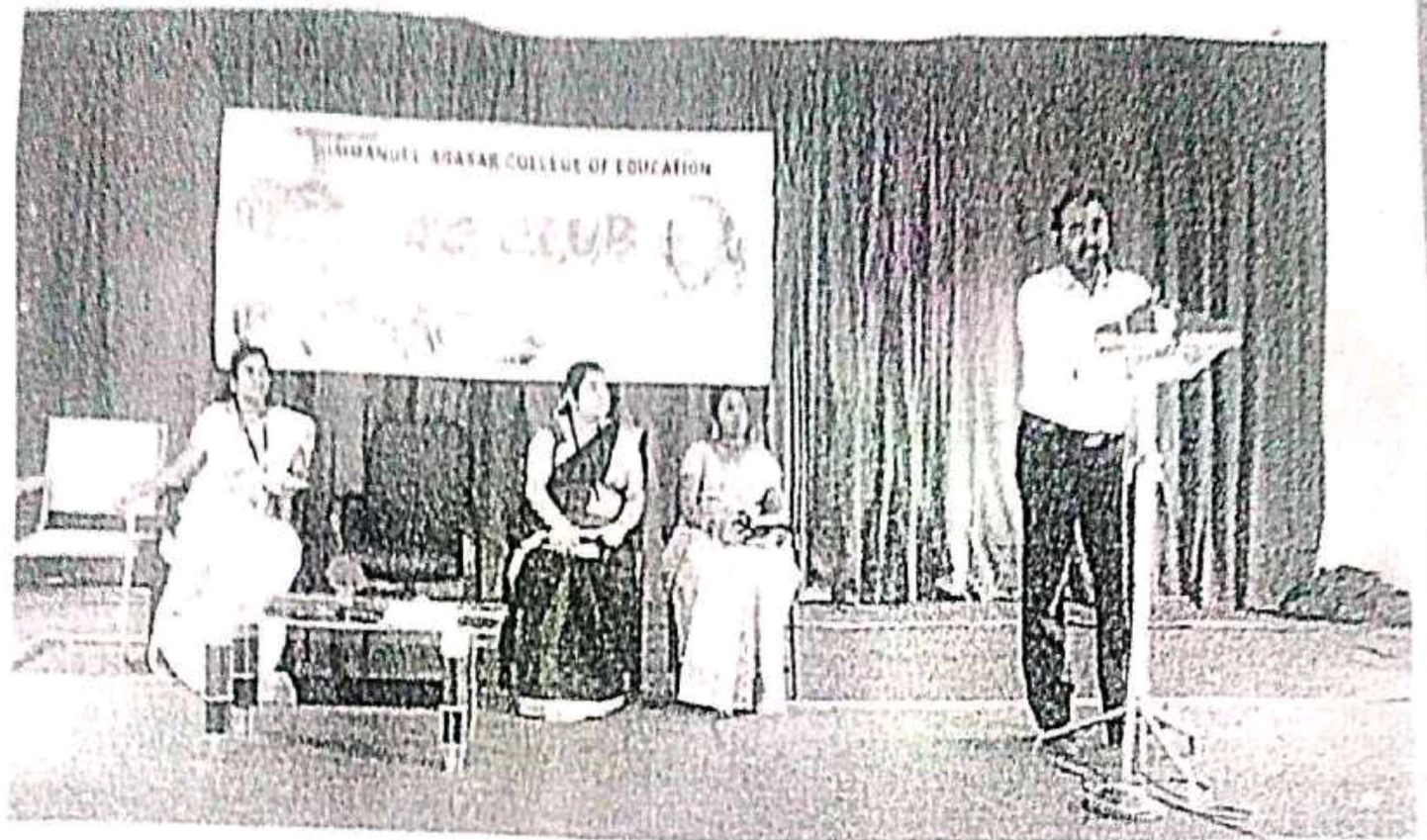

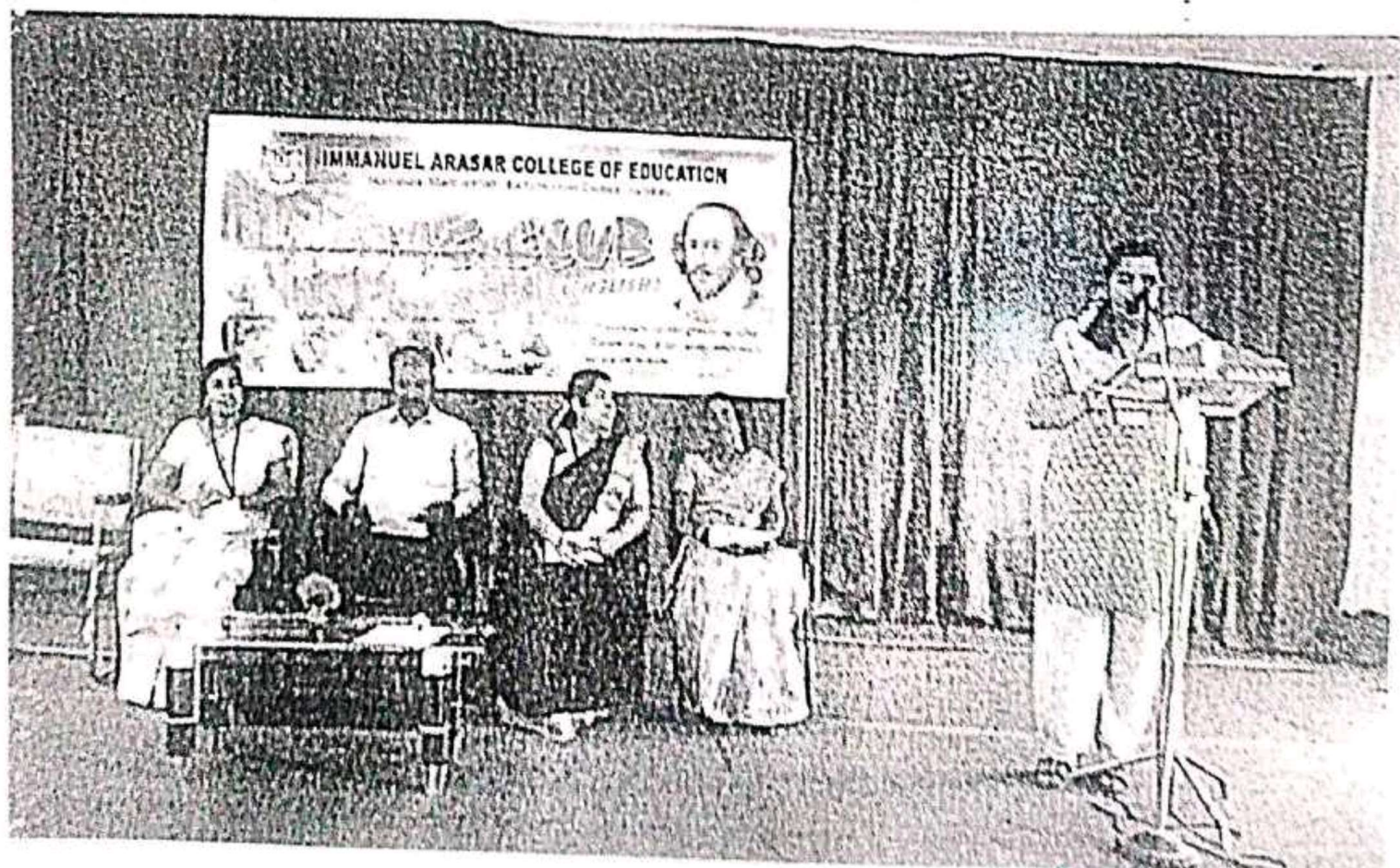
English Workshop [2017-2018]

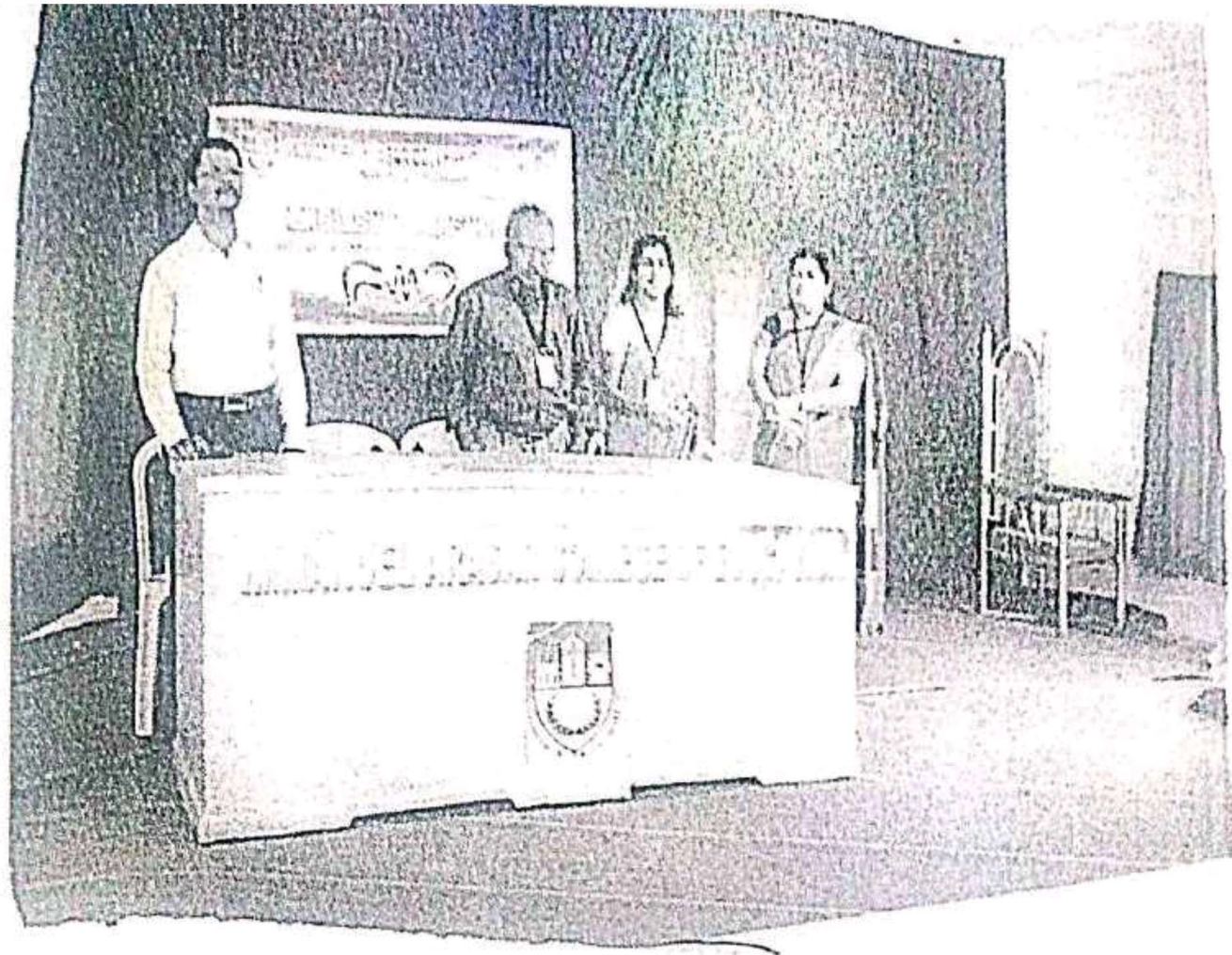
of English to survive and stand in the competitive educational field in India as well as all over the world.

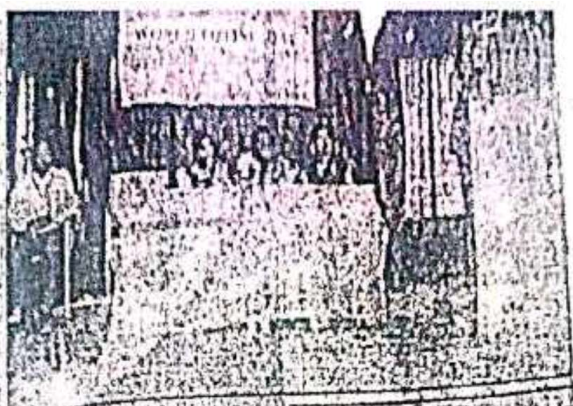

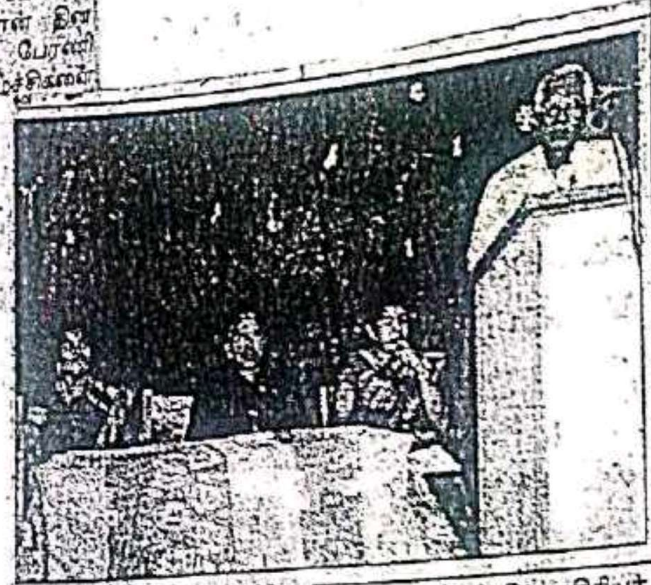
